

School Re-entry

Physical Campus Safety Measures

- Wellness checks
 - Temps taken at door every morning
 - Official fever is 100.5 degrees Fahrenheit
 - 99.5-100.4 will require an immediate temp recheck, general health questioning, and caution to parent. Students in the “caution” range may be required to wait in the lunchroom until 8:15 to be checked again before going into their classroom.
 - Before care/Preschool will still take temps at the door
 - If arriving before 7:45, staff must take their own temps before entering their classrooms/work area.
- Facemasks
 - Required for all students and staff in hallways and settings where social distancing is not able to be maintained.
 - Required/encouraged (see next bullet point) for all teachers in classrooms, kitchen staff, office staff
 - Face coverings must always be worn by anybody entering the kitchen
 - Office staff must wear face coverings in the office unless you are alone in the room
 - Encouraged for students in classrooms, and mandated unless a parent sends a note dismissing them from that mandate. The office will be compiling a class list so each teacher knows who should be wearing their masks at all times in the building.
 - Not required
 - outside, or in when playing in the gym
 - Snacks and Lunch
 - Face Shields are acceptable in place of face masks when it is necessary for students/staff to visibly see your face/lips
- Capacity Limits
 - Lunchroom
 - K5-3rd – 11:15-11:40
 - 4th-6th – 11:45-12:10
 - 7th-12th – 12:17-12:42
 - (Phase 3 would be eating in classrooms)
 - Music – Church Auditorium, or possibly still in Mrs. Summer’s room depending on size of group (Sanitizer Spray after each use, church bathrooms off limits)
 - Gymnasium – Ball mesh bags, cleaned each use, Special things need to be kept for each class.
 - Outdoors as much as possible (Recess, 5 minute walks, reading groups, class time, etc.)
- Daily cleaning
 - Each class has a spray bottle. If you would like to regularly disinfect your room while students are there, please use this spray with paper towels. It is safe on all surfaces (including skin), and is tested and proven to kill Covid-19. It is most effective when sprayed and allowed to air dry, so please spray the touchable surfaces in your room before you leave for the end of the day. Preschool/kitchen may have a different sprayer with a different solution.

School Re-entry

- Sanitizer wipes will be mounted outside the bathrooms. Please have a student take one and wipe down the faucet handles, soap dispenser, and door handle after each “class use” time. Preschool please try to do this regularly throughout the day.
- Ethan/Custodial will be disinfecting lockers, hallways, lunchroom, bathrooms, and gymnasium daily
- Preschool will have a sanitizing mat that will need to be changed every Monday
